In years it's produced, Canalicchio di Sopra crafts its Riserva from a single vineyard of the estate's oldest vines. In 2015, it hails from Vigna Vecchia Mercatale, which countered the vintage's warmth with its northfacing, breezy exposure. Opening slowly, it marries lifted liquorice, dried flowers and baking spice with forest undergrowth and leather. There's plenty of character here with a mouthful of dusty red currants and red cherries. Chewy and vigorous, it

really keeps improving in the glass - but I would put it away for a few more years.
